Michigan Future Educator Fellowship

The fellowship provides Education students with \$10,000 towards their tuition each year for a maximum of three years.

In order to qualify for these funds, you must also meet the additional requirements:

- x File the Free Application for Federa Student Aid (FAFSA)
- x Be a high school graduate.
- x Be enrolled at least fullme or its equivalency.
- x Be working on your first teacher certification.
- x Must have earned at leas 85 emester credits
- x Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0.
- x Be a Michigan resident since July 1 of the previous calendar year.
- x If you are a dependent student, your parent on your FAFSA must also be a Michigan resident since July 1 of the previous calendar year.

If you believe that you have met all of those requirements, you may create an account and apply for the MI Future Educator Fellowshipre. When you apply, youre required to sign a "Commitment to Teach Agreement," which you are agreeing to teach in a MICHIGAN school (public schoolor public preschool program) for a certain number of years.

The agreement is as follows:
