The **minor in History for Secondary teaching** (State Code: CC) consists of a minimum of 26 credits.

Teacher candidates for certification in History at the Secondary level must pass the Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC) in History (Test #009). MTTC content exams should not be taken until 90% of course work in the subject area has been completed.
